

CUSTOMIZE OPENCORE MENU COLORS

Open **config.plist** with a plain text editor

CHANGE ONLY THE NUMBER OF : **PickerAttributes**

```
<key>PickerAttributes</key>  
<integer>112</integer>
```

WITH THIS FORMULA:

CUSTOMCOLORS = EFI_TEXT + EFI_BACKGROUND

EXAMPLES:

WHITE TEXT ON BLACK BACKGROUND = 15 + 0 = 15

BLACK TEXT ON LIGHT GREY BACKGROUND = 0 + 112 = 112

LIGHT GREEN TEXT ON BLACK BACKGROUND = 10 + 0 = 10
