

Voice Mail Preferences

Voice mail tips:

- Call trees usually consist of a menu with choices. A tree holds all the options, announcements and actions available within a call.
- Most users have only one tree. Make more only when using overrides (for different choices by time of day or line called).
- To add choices to a menu, select it and press the + button. The default call tree is shown in bold.
