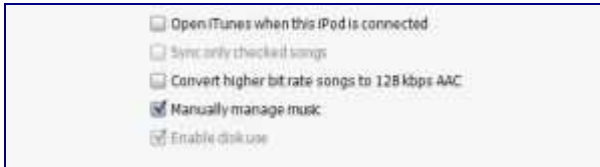
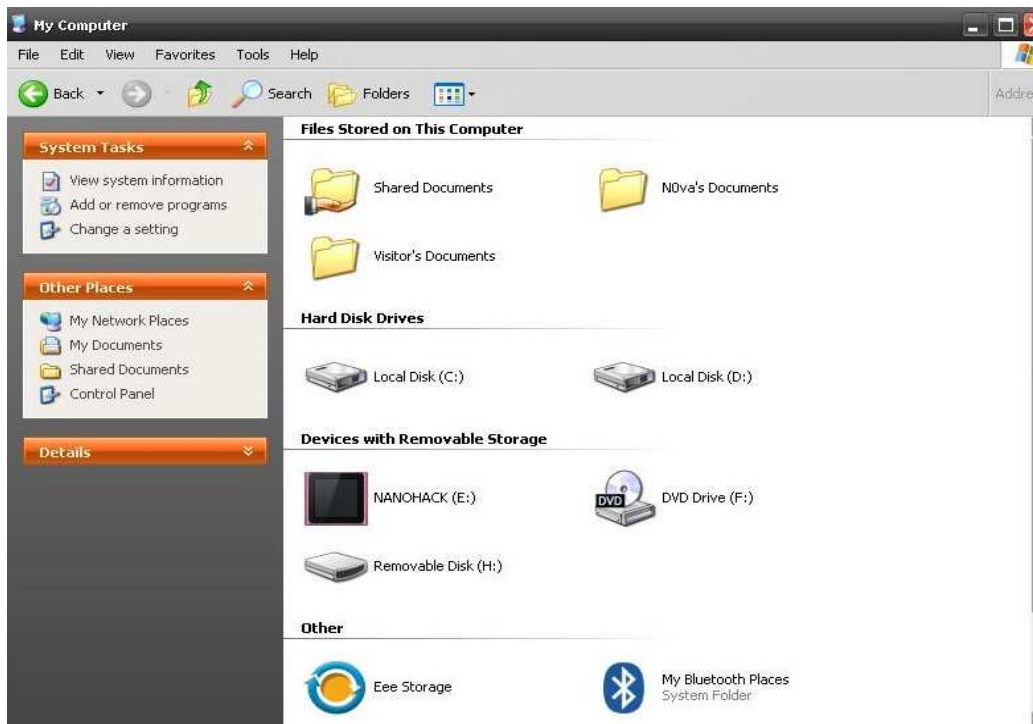


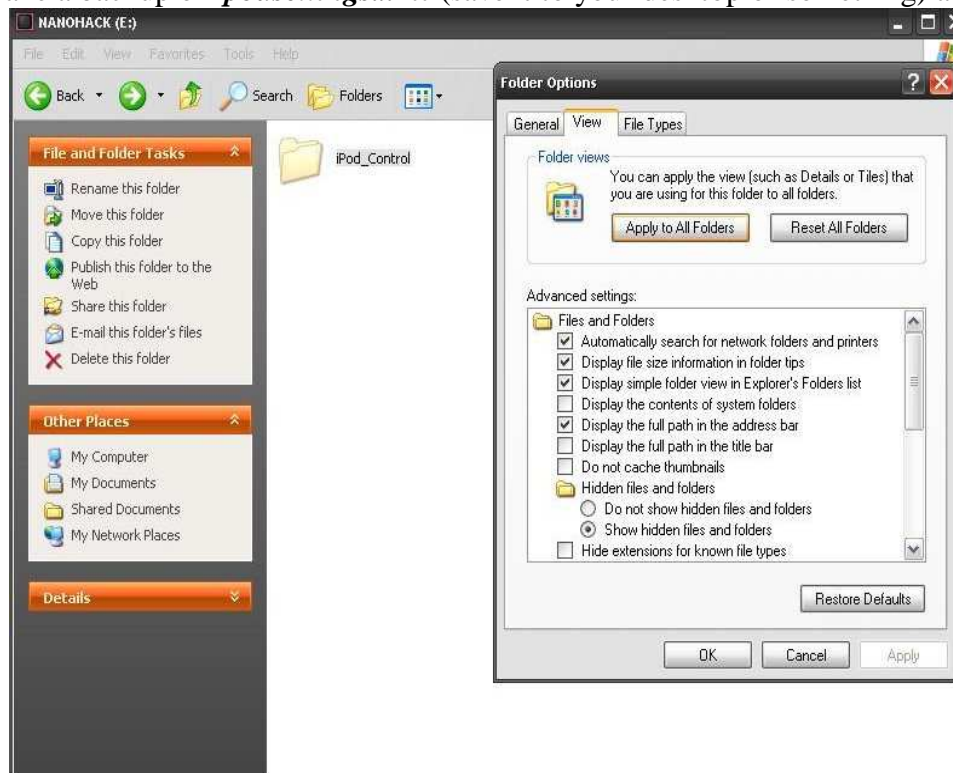
- 1 First say all together many thanks to <http://nanohack.me/> from where most of this pages are taken. Guys the smart one is there....
- 2 Make sure “Enable disk use” is ticked in iTunes when the Nano is plugged in.



- 3 Go to *My Computer* and then into the *Nano*. **Enable hidden folders** and go into the *iPod_Control*, then into *Device*.



- 1 Make a backup of *Ipodsettings.xml* (save it to your desktop or something) and then



proceed to open the original with Notepad or any text editor, here is what you'll see this:

- 1 Find the string **<VolumeLimit>216</VolumeLimit>**. Change the value **216** to **432** (I don't know if 432 it is the maximum value admitted, but for me is sufficient
- 2 Save this file.
- 3 SyncTug it: hold down the minus volume button and lock button at the same time and as soon as it begins to reboot (screen flashes black for a moment), unplug the iPod cable from it.
- 4 Watch it boot and have fun!!!
